

# Report of the Standing Rules Committee

The committee met on two occasions to review the **Standing Rules for CEM Hybrid Conferences** and the **Parliamentary Actions and Guidelines**.

The committee reviewed the clauses of the Standing rules and felt that other than minor wording for clarification, they did not require any adjustments and therefore recommends their continued adoption.

The committee did determine that changes were needed in the parliamentary rules and guidelines. In a hybrid conference, which seems likely to be the continued approach to conference, changes were recommended to:

- accommodate the challenges of online participants to be recognized in a timely manner.
- provide greater clarity regarding the rules used, how they are described, and the priority of action.
