As the number of aging individuals increases rapidly, our focus has been sharpened toward seniors who have been impoverished by mental health challenges, offering them both stability and dignity through affordable housing.

Current Projects:

- **Bill McMurray Residence** in downtown Toronto continues to serve 88 seniors who face mental health challenges and struggle with poverty. Our mission is to provide not just housing but a community of care, offering hope and support for some of our society's most vulnerable individuals.
- **Bathurst Street and St. Clair Apartments** provide essential affordable housing solutions for families in need, supporting individuals and families as they work toward stability and a better future.

Expansion and Growth in 2024:

- We are excited to break ground on a new facility in the northern part of Toronto in 2024. This project will provide 158 seniors with affordable housing, answering the critical need for safe, secure spaces as more people enter retirement age with limited resources.
- We are also expanding our reach beyond Toronto with a new property in Orillia where we plan to partner with the city to build 101 units of affordable housing for seniors. This project is a testament to our continued commitment to addressing the housing crisis that disproportionately affects the elderly.
